## **FORMAT**

**Each match will consist of 3 games, time set at 20 minutes**

**Coaches will have 1 timeout, each 20 minute game**

**4 Minute warm up first round of the pool only**

**Matches will be officiated by each team bench (opposite sides)**

**All teams are required to wear the same color shirts specified by their session date**

## **TEAM ROSTERS**

Team rosters may include up to fifteen (15) people including up to three (3) adult bench personnel. Bench personnel can consist of the following: Head coach, assistant coach, team trainer or chaperone. All bench personnel must be AAU members in the non-athlete category.

Only those three (3) listed on the roster as bench personnel will be permitted to sit on the bench.

**Procedures for bench personnel may differ due to Covid- 19 Safety Protocols.**



## **Covid-19 Protocols and Health Guidelines**

### **Entry Safety Guidelines and Procedures:**

- \* Social Distancing will be strictly enforced, when all possible.
- \* Temperature checks will be administered
- \* Face Masks are to be worn at all times while on property (Also during competition)
- \* Upon arrival, athletes will not be permitted to congregate while waiting to be marshalled in by Jam On It Staff.
- \* While teams are being marshalled in, we ask that spectators do not loiter.
- \* Coolers, tents, or additional seating will not be permitted on the premises.
- \* Once athletes are in the gym, they must not leave until their pool is finished
- \* Specific restrooms will be provided upon entering the sportsplex

### **Before Play:**

- \* Teams will be escorted in and out of the playing areas
- \* Teams must arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of their wave time
- \* Court sanitation will be done in between waves
- \* Practice equipment (Volleyball) will be sanitized after every period of usage between teams

### **On The Court:**

- \* No shaking hands
- \* Teams will play with in the division wave
- \* Teams will not switch sides after games
- \* If teams are not playing, they must be in designated area or off the property



\* Athletes are allowed to bring their personal belongings for game play within moderation (hydros, water bottles).
